### DIRECTIONS

This calendar helps students review reading, writing, and math skills with daily assignments on Paper. Here's a quick guide for each type:

**Missions:** Students can choose their own, or you can select specific ones from the 'practice' tab by clicking the link on the calendar. Note: 8th grade ELA will be refresher missions.

**Paper Reading:** Sign in to Paper and click the link to create the assignment, or explore the library for a different text.

**Pulse Questions:** Create a Pulse Questions assignment using the topic from the calendar or choose your own. Always check for accuracy.

**Live Help Tutoring:** Create a tutoring assignment and attach the linked worksheet, updating it as needed.

**Writing Review & Revision:** Create a writing review assignment with the prompt from the calendar. Have students upload their work when completed. On revision days, students access feedback from the Writing Review Center.
