Learn how to use Teacher Assign for Live Help Sessions, Writing Reviews and Paper Reading.

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Monday: Assign the provided weekly text to your students on Paper Reading.

Tuesday: Assign a Live Help session to your students, providing the corresponding prompt. Students will brainstorm response ideas with a tutor and create an outline of their response.

Wednesday: Assign a Writing Review to your students. They will draft the first version of their writing piece and submit it. *Ask them to use a newly learned vocabulary word.

Thursday: Students will revise their writing using the feedback they receive.

Friday: Assign a Live Help session to your students and direct them to work with a tutor to make any final edits to their writing. Then, they can publish their work!

Make final edits and publish.
WEEK 3	Read and review vocabulary. The Road Not Taken	Brainstorm and write an outline. Prompt: Explain in detail the meaning of this poem, and your interpretations of the various phrases throughout. How does this message apply to your life?	Draft a response and submit to Review Center.	Revise writing using feedback.	Make final edits and publish.
WEEK 4	Read and review vocabulary. <u>Flying High</u>	Brainstorm and write an outline. Prompt: Research a sport of your choosing. Write a news article describing the dangers for the athletes. Explain any rules or safety equipment that exist to make the sport safer.	Draft a response and submit to <i>Review Center.</i>	Revise writing using feedback.	Make final edits and publish.
