## Directions

Use the suggestions below in any of your lessons to enhance your students' math literacy skills. You can assign the work to your students using **Teacher Assign**, or encourage them to log on independently to partner with a tutor and work through their assignments.

### Live Help



Students will...

- Use the **camera** to send a picture of the problem they are working on. Then, use the **recordable whiteboard** to annotate the problem as they work through solving it.
- Solve a math problem independently. Then, use the **camera** to send a picture of the problem and the work they did. Record an **audio note** (using the *microphone icon*) to explain their thinking when solving the problem.
- Receive graded assignments back from their teacher and talk through any missed questions with a tutor. Use the **recordable whiteboard**, **audio note**, and **camera** features to collaborate and solve.

### Paper Missions



Students will...

- Complete problems independently for skill practice of key concepts, remedial topics, or challenging content.

### Pulse Questions



Students will...

- Answer the **pulse questions** assigned by the teacher. Then, create their own question that coincides with the material and would belong in the question set.
- Answer the **pulse questions**. Then, start a **Live Help** chat and review their work and/or thought process with the tutor.

### Review Center



Students will...

- Work through a mathematical situation and write about the strategy (analyze how that solution worked, consider other approaches, and make suggestions for tackling future problems).



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
