<p>Speaker: Identify the voice (narrator) and the POV from which he or she is speaking. Identify the speaker's values, biases, and beliefs.</p>		
<p>Occasion: What is the time and place? Is there a particular historical context that influences the message or speaker? What specific set of circumstances prompted the write?</p>		
<p>Audience: To whom is this piece directed? What assumptions can you make about the audience? Why is the speaker using this type of language?</p>		
<p>Purpose: What is the reason for the text? Why was it written? What goal did the author have in mind? How do you know this from the text?</p>		
<p>Subject: What are the general topics, content, and/or ideas contained in the text. How do you know this from the text?</p>		
<p>TONE: What is the attitude expressed by the speaker? How do you know this? Examine the words and imagery to show where in the text your answer is supported.</p>
