Learn how to use Teacher Assign for <u>Tutoring Sessions and Writing Reviews</u>.

DIRECTIONS

Monday: Assign a Live Help tutoring session attaching the linked worksheet or have students complete a math mission. Students will receive personalized support on their math skills.

Tuesday: Assign a Paper Reading activity to your students using the link on the calendar OR assign a tutoring session to have students go over the text with a Live Help tutor.

Wednesday: Assign a Writing Review to your students using the prompt on the calendar.

Thursday: Assign a Live Help tutoring session to your students to use in your classroom routines to help provide support to all students.

Friday: Assign students to revise their weekly writing with the help of a Live Help tutor.

WEEK 4	Math Support: Have students complete a math mission	Paper Reading: Assign a free read or have students pick their own from the library	Writing Review Prompt: Think about a time when you learned something new that changed the way you view the world. Write a story about that experience, focusing on how it changed your perspective.	Tutoring Session: Assign a tutoring session for students to review classwork as part of a center or station	Tutoring: Have students revise Wednesday's writing with a Live Help Tutor.
